ADDENDUM TO EMPLOYMENT NOTICE NO.: 003/2016 DATED 5TH JULY, 2016 REG. ADVERTISEMENT FOR VARIOUS TEACHING POSITIONS

- 1. The University vide its Employment Notice No.: 003/2016 dated 5th July, 2016 has advertised various Teaching Positions at the level of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in various disciplines on regular / re-employment after superannuation basis.
- 2. With reference to Serial No. 5 of General Instructions of aforementioned Employment Notice No. 003/2016 dated 5th July, 2016, it is hereby informed to all concerned that the Written Examination for the post of Assistant Professor in various disciplines will be held on 13th August, 2016 at Patna (BIHAR). The candidates are required to report at the venue of Written Examination at 8:30 AM sharp. Delayed arrival shall not be allowed to appear in the Written Examination. Tentatively, the venue of the said Written Examination shall be as under:

- 3. The Written Examination is compulsory. However, these Examination will only be of qualifying nature. Assessment will not be done on the basis of marks of such examination.
- 4. The top 5 (five) candidates per post (i.e., for one post five candidates will be short-listed, for two posts ten candidates will be shortlisted and so on) in the order of merit in the Written Examination and are eligible as per eligibility criteria mentioned in the advertisement, shall be considered for short-listing for the personal interview. The list of such candidates, who shall be shortlisted for interview, will be displayed on the Notice Board and Website of the University at 5:00 PM on 16th August, 2016.
- 5. Further, it is clarified that all the applicants are being allowed to appear in the Written Examination without declaring them eligible. The candidate must satisfy themselves about the eligibility, before appearing in the Written Examination. The onus of validity of eligibility of candidates shall rest solely with the candidates. The eligibility as per criteria advertised is subjected to fulfilling the

requisite conditions and will be established only for top 5 (five) candidates per post in the order of merit in the Written Examination. Merely securing good marks in the Written Examination will not make anyone entitled to become eligible for further short-listing for the interview. Each short-listed candidate will be required to bring all original documents/testimonials at the time of Interview for verification in support of his/her eligibility. In case, the candidate is employed in Government/ Semi-Government/Public Undertaking etc., he/she will required to produce No Objection Certificate (NOC) from present employer at the time of Interview (if not applied Through Proper Channel). Please note that NO TA/DA would be admissible for appearing in the Written Examination.

- 6. Prior to Interview, the candidate shall be required to demonstrate ability to teach (communication skills) in front of Selection Committee. The candidates would be required for mock classroom teaching in the respective discipline in the presence of Selection Committee.
- 7. Final Selection will be on the basis of candidate's performance in the Interview.
- 8. Pattern of the Written Examination: The Written Examination will consist of one objective type paper containing 100 questions carrying 100 marks lasting for duration of 90 minutes.

All questions will be of Objective Multiple Choice Type (MCQs). The questions in all the above components will be of Post-graduation level of the subject concerned.

9. Syllabus for the Written Examination:

The syllabus for the Written Examination shall be notified within next few days.

- 10. NEGATIVE MARKING: There will be negative marks for wrong answers. One fourth (i.e., 0.25 marks) marks will be deducted for each wrong answers.
- 11. The Date, Time and Venue of Written Examination is subject to change, in which event the new Date, Time and Venue will be notified through University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in) only. Therefore, the candidates are advised to check the University Website regularly.
- 12. Candidates are not permitted to use Mobile Phone, Calculators or any other electronic/electrical device. Candidates, therefore, MUST NOT bring Mobile Phone, Calculators or any other electronic/electrical device inside the Examination premises. Possession of these items, whether in use or not, will be considered as "use of unfair means" in the Examination and appropriate action will be taken by the University against such candidates.
- 13. Success in the examination confers no right for selection unless the University is satisfied after such verification, as may be considered necessary about the candidate, having regard to his/her conduct in service, that he/she is eligible and suitable in all respects for appointment to the post for which the examination is conducted.

14. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information in filling up the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case correct or alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or its attested/certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or any discrepancy between two or more such documents or their attested/certified copies, an explanation regarding this discrepancy should be submitted.

A candidate who is or has been declared by the University to be guilty of:

- a. Obtaining support of his/her candidature by any means; or
- b. Impersonating; or
- c. Procuring impersonation by any person;
- d. Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with; or
- e. Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information; or
- f. Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the selection; or
- g. Using unfair means during the Written Examination; or
- h. Writing irrelevant matter including obscene language or pornographic matter, in the script(s); or
- i. Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall; or
- Harassing or doing bodily harm to the staff employed by the University for the conduct of their Written Examination; or
- k. Bringing mobile Phone/communication device in the Examination Hall/Interview Room; or
- l. Attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the University of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:
 - i. to be disqualified by the University from selection for which he/she is a candidate; and/or
 - ii. to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period by the:
 - University from any Examination or Selection held by them.
 - University from taking admission under the courses offered by them.
 - iii. if he/she is already in service under Government to disciplinary action under the appropriate rules.

15. RESOLUTION OF TIE CASES:

- a. The tie is resolved by the University by referring to the total marks in the Written Examination i.e. a candidate having more marks in the written examination gets preference over the candidate(s) with less marks.
- b. If the tie still persists, the candidate older in age gets preference.
- c. If the tie still persists, it is finally resolved by referring to the alphabetical order of names i.e. a candidate whose name begins with the alphabet which comes first in the alphabetical order gets preference.

16. UNIVERSITY DECISION FINAL:

The decision of the University in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centres and preparation of merit list will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry/correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

17. COURTS JURISDICTION:

In case of any disputes, any suites or legal proceedings against the Universityin regard to this recruitment, the territorial jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Bihar at District Court at Motihari and High Court at Patna.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. The candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions for admission to the Written Examination. Their admission at all the stages of Written Examination will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If, on verification, at any time before or after the Written Examination, it is found that they do not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the University.
- 2. The candidates must carry at least one latest photo bearing identification proof such as Driving Licence, Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, Identity Card issued by University/College, Income Tax Pan Card in original to the Examination Centre, failing which they shall not be allowed to appear for the same.
- 3. Any attempt to influence the authorities by way of recommendations will ab-initio disqualify the candidate.
