Notice for Open Counselling cum Admission M. A. Economics (Academic Year 2023-24)

- Open Counselling-Cum-Admission process in M.A. Economics programme is scheduled to be held on 4th September 2023 at Department of Economics, Mahatma Gandhi Central University for CUET Score Card holders and without CUET Score Card holders.
- 2. The admission Process is open for all students irrespective of their participation in CUET (PG) 2023, i.e. Any Candidate who could not participate in CUET (PG) 2023, may take admission after fulfilling other eligibility criteria. However, the candidates appeared in CUET (PG) 2023 in Economics Subject shall be given priority in admission process.
- 3. The details of vacant seats are mentioned in the table given below after first round of counselling process.

4. Eligibility Criteria:

Bachelor's Degree from a recognised Indian or Foreign University having Economics/Commerce/Statistics/Management/Mathematics as a Subject (Honours/General) with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for Unreserved (Open) Category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/PWD/EWS categories.

- 5. The merit of without CUET Card holders shall be determined on the basis of Composite Score obtained by considering marks obtained by candidates in 10th, 12th and Graduate Examinations.
- 6. How to Apply:

All the interested and eligible candidates are required to fill Online Application Form by clicking the link given below on or before 01/09/2023. Without filling the Online Application Form, the candidates shall not be allowed to participate in the counselling process scheduled to be held on 4th September 2023.

Fee of Registration: Candidates, who are interested in appearing for Open Counselling and have not paid the registration fees to MGCUB, will be required to pay registration fees (INR 500/- for General/OBC/EWS category, INR 200/- for SC/ST/PWD category) on the date of Open Counselling through Bank Challan as per details given below.
- 8. All the registered candidates through Google Form shall be called for Open Counselling cum Admission Process scheduled to be held as per details given below. A merit list shall be prepared according to admission policy of the University on the same day and offer of admission shall be provided to selected candidates as per merit. A candidate who will be absent during the said counselling process will not be considered in any case for admission process.

Important Instructions

- 1. Admission shall be based on CUET (PG) 2023 score.
- Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with the required documents.
- **3.** Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
- 4. In case of a tie, the senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
- 5. The admission of a candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
- **6.** The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of Challan at the time of admission.
- 7. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
- Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
- **9.** In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
- 10. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.

- 5. Mark sheet and Certificate of Graduation.
- 6. Five copies of recent passport-size photographs.
- 7. Self-attested copy of AADHAR card.
- 8. Bank Account detail of student i.e. Account No., IFSC-Code, Name of account holder & address of Bank.
- 9. A Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- 10. Transfer/Migration Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
- 11. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years, if applicable on 10/- stamp paper.
- 12.Valid SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
- 13.No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Employers, wherever applicable.
