Dr. Vikas Sharma is an Associate Professor of English at CCS University Meerut. He has receved PhD from Kumaun University, Nainital and D.Litt. from CCS University, Meerut. He has been editor of Notions, a peer-reviewed journal of English literature, and member of Editorial Board, Research Journal of English (RJOE). Dr. Vikas has also held the position of Principal of D.A.V. P.G. College, Bulandshahr (UP).

Romanticism In English Literature

In his lecture, Dr Vikas will explore various aspects of romanticism, a literary movement in the early half of the nineteetth century British literature, felt across the globe through various names as transcendentalism in America and *chayavaad* in India. The romantic poets include Wordsworth, Colerdige, Shelly, Byron, and Keats who have held sway over English literature across cultures. Charged with the spirit of revolution—consequent upon french revolution, this movement brough a cataclysmic change in the notion of literature itself and defined poetry as "a sponataneous overflow of powerful feelings".
