4. The Vice-Chancellor extended a warm welcome and thanked each of them for attending the $2^{\text {nd }}$ (Special) Meeting of the Executive Council despite their busy schedule.
5. Thereafter, the Vice-Chancellor invited Dr Sujit Kumar, OSD (Administration)-cumSecretary to take up the agenda item and the following Agenda was taken up for discussion:

## ITEM FOR CONSIDERATION AND DECISION:

Item No: EC (2017):02:01 To place before the Executive Council, the recommendations of the Selection Committees for the post of Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in various disciplines held from 25 $^{\text {th }}$ to 29 $^{\text {th }}$ of September 2016.

The University Grants Commission, New Delhi vide its letter No.F.83-1/2015 (CU) dated 17th February 2016 granted approval for opening of 20 teaching departments with teaching strength in the ratio of 1:2:4 (One Professor, Two Associate Professors and Four Assistant Professors) with 140 teaching positions (20 Professors, 40 Associate Professors and 80 Assistant Professors).

Since the University was in its nascent stage and keeping in view the shortage of space in the building provided by the State Government on rent basis, the University decided to open 15 teaching departments in the initial and accordingly, the University vide its Employment Notice No. 003/2016 dated 5th July 2016 issued on $13^{\text {th }}$ July 2016 had advertised various teaching positions at the level of Professor, Associate Professor \& Assistant Professor in various disciplines on regular/re-employment after superannuation basis with the last date of receipt of application as 5th August 2016:

Out of the above, 15 posts of Professor, 30 posts of Associate Professor, 01 post at each level will be reserved for Persons with Disability and out of 60 posts of Assistant Professor, two posts will be reserved for Persons with Disability.

The University vide its addendum to the Employment Notice No. 003/2016 dated $5^{\text {th }}$ July, 2016 on 19th July 2016 (ANNEXURE - 'B') informed all the concerned candidates that a Written Screening Test containing 100 Multiple Choice Questions carrying 100 marks lasting for duration of 90 minutes would be held for the position of Assistant Professor in fifteen programmes on 13th August 2016 at

Nalanda Open University, Patna for bringing down the number of candidates to be called for Interview to 5 (Five) (i.e., for one post five candidates will be short-listed, for two posts ten candidates will be shortlisted and so on, in the order of merit in the Written Examination) candidates per post.

The said Written Screening Test was compulsory but of qualifying nature only. Assessment was not done on the basis of marks of such Examination. Final selection was made on the basis of candidate's performance in the Mock Class Room Teaching and Interview.

Keeping in view the flood situation in many parts of the Country and on the basis of requests received from many applicants by telephone/email, the University had extended the last date of receipt of application from $5^{\text {th }}$ August 2016 to $8^{\text {th }}$ August 2016.

With reference to aforesaid Employment Notice, the University received a large number of applications, as per detail given below:

The result of Written Screening Test for the post of Assistant Professor for each Department alongwith the Provisional List of candidates short-listed for Interview for various Teaching Positions at the level of Assistant Professor in various disciplines was uploaded on the University Website on $17^{\text {th }}$ August 2016 with the advice to the candidates to go through their details carefully and in case of any discrepancy, they may bring the same to the notice of the University for necessary correction(s) latest by $20^{\text {T }}$ AUGUST, 2016.

The applications of the candidates who were short-listed for Interview were placed before the Screening Committee to determine eligibility of each applicant and screen-out such applicants who did not meet the prescribed minimum eligibility requirements as per UGC Regulations as amended from time to time.

The final list of candidates short-listed for Interview for the post of Assistant Professor in various disciplines was prepared on the basis of the following:
a. The top 5 (five) candidates per post (i.e, for one post first five candidates were short-listed, for two posts first ten candidates were shortlisted and so on) in the order of merit in the Written Screening Examination and who are eligible as per eligibility criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
b. The candidates who have applied separately for reserved \& unreserved category and secured sufficient marks in the Written Screening Examination have been short-listed under both reserved and unreserved category.
c. In case of tie, the candidate older in age gets preference

The applications received for the post of Professor and Associate Professor in various disciplines were also screened by the Screening Committee. The Screening Committee checked and verified the records of each applicant and determined their eligibility strictly in accordance with the minimum qualifications prescribed by the University vide Employment Notice No. 003/ 2016 dated 5 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ July 2016; UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education 2010 and its subsequent amendments issued in year 2011/2013/2016 published in the Gazette of India.

Since the number of eligible applicants for the positions of Professor and Associate Professor in each disciplines were not very large, the Screening Committee decided that all eligible applicants who meet the minimum eligibility requirements may be short-listed to be called to appear before the Selection Committee for Expert Assessment and Interview.
