Notice for Open Counseling-Cum-Admission of M.Sc. Chemistry Admission (2022-23)

All the candidates who have valid CUET 2022 score card and met the eligibility criteria for the admission in M.Sc Chemistry at Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari may appear for open counseling for filling up the vacant seats left.

Vacant Seats: UR-04; OBC-8; SC-4; ST-2; EWS-3

Eligibility Criteria: B.Sc (Honors) degree in Chemistry or Bachelor degree of three years duration with Chemistry as a subject till 3rd Year as one of the subject of study from a recognized Indian or Foreign University (Foreign recognition to per as per AIU list) with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer)/PWD candidates

Fee of Registration: The candidates who are interested to appear in open counseling can pay Registration fee on the date of open counseling through Bank Challan.

Category wise registration Fee is given under:

- Rupees five hundred (Rs. 500) for General/OBC/EWS
- Rupees Two Hundred (Rs.200) for SC/ST/PWD

All the eligible candidates are advised to appear for counseling for admission to the above programme on the scheduled **DATE AND TIME** in the **Department of Chemistry, MCGU, Motihari, Bihar.**

Important Instruction

1. Candidates are advised to follow the COVID guidelines at the time of counselling.
2. Admission shall be based on CUET (PG) – 2022 score.
3. Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with required documents.



4. All candidates are advised to check their eligibility for respective programmes as notified by NTA Information Bulletin for the admission in PG programme through CUET (PG) – 2022. (<https://cdnbbsr.s3waas.gov.in/s3d1a21da7bca4abff8b0b61b87597de73/uploads/2022/05/2022051961.pdf>)
5. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
6. In case of tie, senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
7. The admission of candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
8. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of **Challan** at the time of admission.
9. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
10. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
11. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
12. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.

8. Transfer/Migration Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
9. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years, if applicable on 10/- stamp paper.
10. Valid SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
11. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Employers, wherever applicable.
