## **APPEAL TO GENERAL PUBLIC**

Attention of the General Public is drawn to the fact that despite of the knowledge that approximately 300 acres land near Bankat-Bairiya Village, selected / proposed by the State Government for establishment of Mahatma Gandhi Central University, **some unscrupulous elements are excavating and digging fertile soil and creating gorges in the land, which is a huge loss for the University.** In addition, due to such type of instance, the General Public of Bihar and especially Mothari (District – East Champaran) are also getting affected in indirect way, i.e., due to which the process of construction of the own Campus of University would take much more time and money than the usual expected time and money.

As you all are aware that the Mahatma Gandhi Central University is a new Central University established under Central Universities (Amendment) Act 2014 (No. 35 of 2014) of Indian Parliament, which received the assent of the President on the 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2014. The University became functional w.e.f. 3<sup>rd</sup> February, 2016 (A/N) with the assumption of charge by the undersigned as its First Vice-Chancellor.

The territorial jurisdiction of the University is North of River Ganges in the State of Bihar (Motihari in East Champaran). Since the place was the “KARAMBHOOMI” of the father of the nation, where he successfully experimented with the idea of “SATYAGRAH” during the “NEEL ANDOLAN” at Champaran in 1917, therefore, the University is named as “MAHATMA GANDHI CENTRAL UNIVERSITY”.

Keeping above in view, the undersigned on behalf of the Mahatma Gandhi Central University hereby requests the General Public that if anyone observes such type of illegal activity of causing damage to the land and trees in the said proposed land, they may bring the same to the notice of Local Police and University, so that a strict necessary legal action could be taken against such person.

The District Magistrate of Motihari (District – East Champaran) has also been briefed on the subject and he has also assured that necessary action will be taken against such unscrupulous elements.
