The list of all candidates along with marks scored by them in Masters Entrance Test (MET), who appeared in the said Written Examination on 23rd July 2017 was uploaded on the University Website on 25th July 2017 for information of all concerned. Based on the information filled by the applicant while applying (i.e., both through ONLINE and OFFLINE) w.r.t. marks scored by them in Matric, 10+2 / Intermediate, Under-Graduate (UG) and Marks scored by them in Masters Entrance Test (MET), the aforesaid Final Merit List has been prepared.

3. **PROCEDURE ADOPTED FOR PREPARATION OF FINAL MERIT LIST:** The **Final Merit List** has been prepared on the basis of following:

STEP 1: The candidates who have secured the **Minimum Eligibility Marks** in the **last Qualifying Examination** (i.e., Under-Graduate) as detailed below, have been considered for selection:

Sl	Category	Minimum Eligibility Marks in Qualifying Examination (UG)
i.	General	60%
ii.	SC/ST/PwD	55%
iii.	OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)	55%

STEP 2: Those candidates who became eligible (*as per Minimum Eligibility condition as mentioned in STEP 1 on pre-page*) and have scored **Minimum Cut-Off Marks** as detailed below (*as conveyed to the candidates vide [Clause 4 in the Important Instructions to the Candidates dated 19th July 2017](#) uploaded on the University Website on 19th July 2017*) have been considered for final selection:

5. The selected candidates as per Final Merit List are required to register and verify their academic qualifications / documents **in person only** at Temporary Campus of the University at Zila School Campus, Motihari, District – East Champaran, Bihar on **10th August 2017** from **10:00 AM to 12:30 PM**:

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE: Those candidates who fail to register themselves in the Programme of Study as per the schedule given above would lose their seat and shall not have any claim after 10th August 2017 (12:30 PM), in any circumstances.

6. The selected candidates have to bring the following documents at the time of registration in the University:

A. Original documents to be shown to the Admission Committee and one self-attested copy of each document to be submitted:

- i. Marksheets of Matriculation, 10+2 and UG.
- ii. Category Certificate, if applicable (OBC certificate should not be issued later than six months).
- iii. Kashmiri Migrant Certificate, if applicable.
- iv. Disabilities Certificate, if applicable.

B. Original Documents to be submitted:

- i. Transfer Certificate
- ii. Migration Certificate

- iii. Character Certificate
- iv. Affidavit by student for intervening period/ over a gap of three years, if applicable
- v. Employer's No Objection Certificate, if applicable
- vi. Two Passport size photographs

7. **The admission shall be strictly provisional** subject to the verification of Academic qualifications and documents at the time of registration and shall be cancelled in case of submission of false information / qualifications by candidate. In such a case, the fees deposited by the candidate may be refunded as per University norms.

(IMPORTANT NOTE: Since many seats are lying vacant in PG Courses, the University reserves the right to fill-up the VACANT SEATS on the basis of NEW CRITERIA to be decided after the Admissions are completed as per the Final Merit List as found in ANNEXURE – 1. Therefore, the candidates are hereby advised to check the University Website regularly.

<p>NOTE: The fees payable by the students is fixed by the Executive Council on the recommendation of the Academic Council / Finance Committee and is notified in the Admission Brochure / Prospectus issued by the University.</p> <p>1. An additional fee towards 'Professional Development Fund' shall be chargeable as under:</p>					

(a) Rs.5000/- per Semester from the students admitted to M.B.A., M.S.W. and B.Tech. Programme of Study.

(b) Rs.1000/- per Semester from the students admitted to UG Programme(s) of Study excluding B.Com. (Honours) and B.Tech.

(c) Rs.2000/- per Semester for B.Com. (Honours) Programme of Study which shall be used in Skill Enhancement Activities such as Tally, Accounts etc. apart from other professional development activities.

2. **CORE Services:** The Community Outreach and Extension (CORE) Services – Programme initiated in the University is of an example of multi-disciplinary academic/research/extension work. Core Services has three sub-units namely:

- **SERVE** : Service for Empowerment and Rural Voluntary Efforts
- **SETU** : Service for Empowerment and Tribal Upliftment
- **SUDHAR** : Service for Urban Development and Human Action Research

3. There shall be separate fee for issuance of duplicate Identification Card of the University as decided by the Competent Authority in this regard.

4. Teaching Learning Resource Fund fee comprises the charges for resource platform(s) and/or material for course(s) of study by concerned faculty member.

5. Health & Insurance Fee comprises the charges for insurance to be provide to students admitted in the university and other related charges such as health awareness, medical check-up camp etc.

6. Training & Placement Fee shall be used in capacity building of the students, pre-placements talks, campus drive for placements etc. to make them employable.

7. Subject Association Fund shall be used in students' club/society related to concerned Programme of Study to create the interest of students in particular subject by student centric activities, academic and quasi academic in nature.

8. University Magazine Fee shall be charged towards **Parisar Pratibimb** and **Parisar Pratibha**- monthly and annual magazine of the university respectively.

9. Tuition fee for offering audit course and 'I' grade will be Rs.100/- per credit.

10. For 'F', 'I' and audit course, examination fee will be Rs.100/- per credit.

11. The University shall charge separate fee for issuing the following certificate(s)/documents as decided by competent authority:

- *Character Certificate*
- *Migration Certificate*
- *Provisional Result*
- *Provisional Degree*
- *Duplicate Marks-Sheet*
- *Duplicate Degree*
