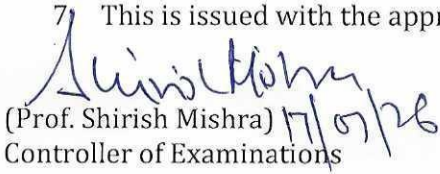

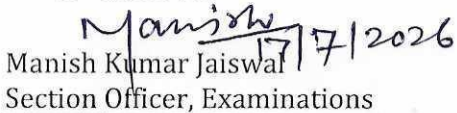
Subject: Admission against Vacant Seats (Post Graduate Programme) through Open Counselling.

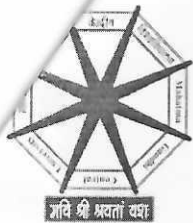
1. This is with reference to Notification No. MGCUB/CoE/2026/CUET/PG, dated: 27th May 2026 and office order no. MGCUB/CoE/2026/CUET/PG, Dated: 04th July 2026 pertaining to the admission process in various PG Programmes of Studies in the University for the Academic Session: 2026-27.
2. In this context, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the Competent Authority has been pleased to order that Heads of various Teaching Departments may go for open admission to fill vacant seats by inviting applications for the admissions through Samarth Portal.
3. The Heads of various Teaching Departments shall notify for the vacant Seats with Category wise seat details for open admissions along with the Link for application.
4. Candidates who are interested to take admission in the PG programmes of this University for Academic Session 2026-2027 are informed to register themselves on MGCUB/Samarth Portal by paying the non refundable registration fee Rs. 500/- for General/OBC/EWS and Rs. 200/- for SC/ST/PWD for each programme from 21st July 2026 to 31st July 2026.
5. The eligible criteria for the above-stated Programmes are enclosed here along with programme wise prescribed fee of the Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Bihar.
6. The Open admission process/Counselling of such candidates is to be completed latest by 10th August 2026, following the criteria as prescribed by **Annexure-1**, The Heads of various Teaching Departments shall ensure to inform such candidates/applicants through e-mail as well as publish notice on the Website of the University.

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Annexure- I

Criteria of Open Counselling (P. G. Programmes, Academic Session 2026-27)

- (i) Open Counselling will be initiated by the Departments against the vacant seats for following category of candidates:
- CUET Score Card holders (first preference)
 - Without CUET Score Card holders (but fulfilling eligibility criteria of MGCUB)
- (ii) During Open Counselling, the admission shall be made on the merit of CUET Score Once such candidates are exhausted, merit will be prepared based on composite score to be determined on the basis of score obtained in 10th, 12th & Graduation as per following details:

Sl. No.	Components	Weightage of different components of the Composite Score (out of 100)
1.	Percentage of marks in 10 th	20%
2.	Percentage of marks in 10+2/Intermediate	35%
3.	Percentage of marks in Graduation	45%
