Important Instructions

1. Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with the required documents (List given below).
3. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
4. In case of a tie, the senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
5. The admission of a candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
6. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
7. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
8. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
9. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check their eligibility to their satisfaction.

Criteria of Open Counselling

(5 Years Integrated UG-PG Programme, Academic Session 2026-27)

During Open Counselling, the admission shall be made on the merit of CUET Score. Once such candidates are exhausted, **merit will be prepared based on the composite score to be determined on the basis of the scores obtained in 10th and 12th as per the following:**

Weightage of different components of the Composite Score (out of 100)

1. The percentage of marks in 10 will be given a weightage of 45%
2. Percentage of marks in 10+2/ Intermediate will be given a weightage of 55%

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The candidates are required to be present in person and bring the following documents in Original as well as a set of attested photocopies at the time of reporting for admission:

1. CUET(UG)–2026 Application Form (If available)
2. Mark sheets and certificates of 10th and 12th.
3. Two copies of recent passport-size photographs.
4. Self-attested copy of AADHAR card.
5. Transfer Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
6. A Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
7. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years, if applicable on 10/- stamp paper.
8. Valid SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
9. Anti-ragging forms duly signed by the students & parents/guardians.
