1. From the pool of candidates who **report within due time on the day of counseling 18 Aug, 2026**, admission would be done in order of merit for all the candidates in respect of 11 Supernumerary Self Finance/ Paid seats for B.Com.-M.Com. (5 Years Integrated UG-PG Programme in Commerce) as per the following

Criteria of Open Counselling (5 Years Integrated UG-PG Programme, Academic Session 2026-27)

- (i) Open Counselling will be initiated by the Departments against the vacant seats for following category of candidates:
 - CUET Score Card holders (first preference, along with eligibility criteria of MGCUB)
 - Without CUET Score Card holders (but fulfilling eligibility criteria of MGCUB)
- (ii) During Open Counselling, the admission shall be made on the merit of CUET Score Once such candidates are exhausted, merit will be prepared based on composite score to be determined on the basis of score obtained in 10th and 12th as per following details:

2. **Fee** payable at the time of admission into the B.Com.-M.Com. (5 Years Integrated UG-PG Programme in Commerce) programme is **Rs. 19,218/-** for **self-finance seats**. The fee would be deposited on the day of admission after document verification on Samarth portal.
3. If at any stage it is found that the applicant has furnished wrong information in the online application form then the admission would be cancelled.
4. **Admission** into the programme **would be confirmed only after document verification** and submission of **proof of fee deposit**.
5. **Admission of candidates seeking admission after a gap of three or more academic years of passing Intermediate/10+2 examination from any University/educational institution/Board, shall be subject to the clearance by the Admission Review Committee** consisting of the Dean, Students' Welfare (DSW), the Dean of the School concerned, the Head of the Department concerned and the Proctor.
